

2023 Firefighter I & II Academy PROGRAM ANNOUNCEMENT January 7th, 2023 – June 3rd, 2023

The York County Chiefs Association is pleased to announce its 2023 Firefighter I & II Academy, using the International Fire Service Training Association (IFSTA) Essentials of Firefighting, 7th Edition curriculum.

This program meets or exceeds the requirements of NFPA 1001; Standard for Firefighter Professional Qualifications, 2013 edition. The academy prepares the student for Pro Board Certification through Maine Fire Service Institute, which will be offered at the completion of the YCCA FF I & II Academy.

The student must possess the aptitude and cognitive learning skills to comprehend college level education. The course is offered in conjunction with the Maine Fire Service Institute, York County Fire/EMS Office, and Southern Maine Community College. Applicants successfully obtaining certification are eligible to receive college credit for this course.

Application Deadline: Friday, November 18th, 2022 @ 4:00 pm. Only completed applications will be accepted. Completed applications shall include signatures for the medical information section, and fire chief authorization.

Priority Registration: York County Fire Departments will have priority on registrations received on or before October 31st, 2022. After November 1st, all received applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis.

All candidates are encouraged to submit their completed applications early in the process.

Acceptance Letters: Acceptance letters will be emailed on November 21st, 2022.

Tuition: \$750 for departments within York County, \$850 for departments outside York County, \$950 for departments outside Maine. Tuition includes textbook, student manuals, and required uniform shirt.

Student Orientation: December 6th, 2022 @ 6:00 pm – Location: Saco Fire Department 271 North St. Saco, ME, 04072

Class Schedule: Classes will begin on January 7th, 2023, and are scheduled for most Saturdays, with some full Saturday & Sundays classes scheduled, concluding on or about June 3rd, 2023. A full course schedule will be made available at the Student Orientation Night.

Minimum Number of Students: 12. The course may be cancelled if minimum enrollment is not met prior to November 18th, 2022. Maximum Number of Students: 24.
